Shiron lost her battle with a liver disorder on January 9, 2007 before she was able to receive a transplant for which SRU students helped raise funds. Those funds are now being used to support this scholarship in Shiron's memory. While at SRU, Shiron majored in business, performed with the "Panorama" steelpan ensemble and International Dinner, and brightened the campus with her never-ending smile and friendship. In her home country of Trinidad and Tobago, Shiron was a talented athlete prior to her illness and then switched her energies to steelpan for which she also received numerous accolades and awards.

Criteria for consideration include a 3.0 cumulative QPA and essay about the importance of family. Applicants must also be from a Caribbean country and preference will be given to business majors, followed by music majors and members of the College of Humanities and Fine and Performing Arts students.

Financial need is not a requirement and there is no limitation on students academic year.
