PRAXIS II – Exams are available only as paper-based tests offered on September 12, November 14, January 9, March 13, April 24, June 12, and July 24.

From PDE Professional Educator Testing Memorandum #07, April 29, 2005:

“Effective September 1, 2005, students being recommended for a School Principal’s certificate, Administrative Area Code #1115, will be able to meet their testing requirements through the use of PRAXIS test #410 Educational Leadership: Administration and Supervision in order to receive their certificate. This test requires a passing score of 580. Previously the PRAXIS assessment #1010, School Leaders Licensure Assessment was used to meet this testing requirement.

“Any applicant who has already taken/passed the School Leader’s Licensure Assessment Test, which required a score of 159, may still receive their Principal’s certificate provided that their application is received prior to September 1, 2010.”

*Cost does NOT include \$50 one-time, non-refundable registration fee which covers all paper-based tests taken in the same testing year.

Test Sessions: 1) first session is at 7:30 a.m.; 2) second session is at 10:45 a.m.
