Community health prepares students to work with individuals, groups, and families in the worksite, health behavior organizations, university health services, wellness centers, and employee health behavior programs at the local, state, and federal level. Community health addresses the physical, mental, and environmental health concerns of communities and population at risk for disease and injury.
