

# What Can I Do With a Degree in HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

The Health Services Administration program prepares students to take on decision-making roles within the health care environment. Graduates may go on to roles in a variety of health care facilities, including nursing homes, hospitals, clinics, and managed care organizations. Duties may vary, but include management duties such as planning and coordinating departmental activities to personnel and staffing, purchasing, public relations, fund raising, and program evaluation. Health Service Administrators work closely with physicians and institutional governing bodies, and governmental regulators.
