DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF APPLICATION

(Please print in ink or type all portions of the application form.)

1. Please make sure you complete the entire application. It is your responsibility to make certain that **ALL** your application materials are received by the University. Applicants for admission in fall, spring and summer are advised to apply by July 1, November 1 and March 1 respectively. Applications are reviewed on a continuing basis or until programs are filled.
2. A non-refundable fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) must accompany the application for admission to graduate study. The fee must be paid by check or money order made payable to Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania.
3. It is the applicant's responsibility to file with the Office of Graduate Admissions an official transcript for all colleges or universities attended. To be considered "official," the transcript must come directly from the institution where the work was completed and must bear the official institutional seal. Transcripts of Slippery Rock University graduates will be requested for the applicant by the Office of Graduate Admissions.
4. All degree applicants to graduate programs are required to submit official scores from the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) general test, unless otherwise noted by individual program or graduate admissions policy. The MAT (Miller Analogies Test) may be substituted for the GRE for all programs except physical therapy, history and sport management. Request official test results be sent to the Graduate Admissions Office (GRE School Code 2658), Slippery Rock University. Access the GRE Web site at www.gre.org or the MAT Web site at www.milleranalogies.com for test registration information.
5. Please refer to the on-line Graduate Catalog, individual program information sheets, or the Graduate Admissions Web site (www.sru.edu/graduate) for specific program information and admissions requirements.
6. Applicants to initial graduate level teacher certification programs in Pennsylvania are advised they must have evidence of successful completion of six credits of math and six credits of English in their undergraduate degree. Students who have not completed the math and English requirement cannot be granted unconditional admittance until the requirement is fulfilled.
